Kathmandu City Exploration - Day 1

The journey continues to the peaceful Boudhanath Stupa, one of the largest Buddhist stupas in the world and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Surrounded by monasteries, prayer wheels, colorful flags, Tibetan cafés, incense shops, and monks chanting prayers, Boudhanath offers a peaceful and spiritual experience.

During the evening, travelers may explore local streets, taste authentic Nepali and Tibetan cuisine, enjoy cafés around the stupa area, or shop for traditional handicrafts and prayer items.

Kathmandu City Exploration: Day 2
