Detailed Itinerary

Day 1: Flight from Kathmandu to Lukla (2,860m) and Trek to Phakding (2,610m)

Walking Duration: 3–4 Hours

Walking Distance: Approx. 8 km

Maximum Elevation: 2,860m

Your Everest Base Camp Luxury Tour begins with an early morning scenic mountain flight from Kathmandu to Lukla, the gateway to the Everest region. Enjoy breathtaking aerial views of the Himalayan range before landing at the famous Tenzing-Hillary Airport.

After meeting your trekking crew, begin a gentle trek through traditional Sherpa villages, prayer wheels, mani walls, and beautiful pine forests alongside the Dudh Koshi River before reaching Phakding.

Accommodation: Best available luxury lodge/comfortable tea house with attached bathroom facilities where available.

Day 2: Trek from Phakding (2,610m) to Namche Bazaar (3,440m)

Walking Duration: 6-7 Hours

Walking Distance: Approx. 11 km

Maximum Elevation: 3,440m

Cross several suspension bridges, including the iconic Hillary Suspension Bridge, while following the Dudh Koshi River through Sagarmatha National Park.

If weather permits, enjoy your first glimpse of Mount Everest before the final climb to Namche Bazaar, the vibrant Sherpa capital and gateway to Everest.

Q: What is the Everest Base Camp Luxury Tour with Helicopter Return?

Spring (March , April and May) and autumn (September, October and November) are the best seasons for Everest trekking, offering clear mountain views, stable weather, and comfortable temperatures.

The helicopter return saves several days of descending on foot while providing spectacular aerial views of Mount Everest, glaciers, valleys, and the entire Khumbu region.

Q: Is the helicopter flight included in the package?

Yes, the helicopter flight from Gorakshep to Lukla is included in the Everest Base Camp Heli Return Tour Package.

Q: What accommodation is provided during the trek Everest?

Yes, comprehensive travel insurance covering high-altitude trekking, emergency medical treatment, and helicopter evacuation is strongly recommended.

Q: Is altitude sickness a concern on this EBC trek?

Altitude sickness can affect anyone at high elevations. Our itinerary includes proper acclimatization days in Namche Bazaar and Dingboche to help reduce the risk.

Q: What should I do if I experience altitude sickness symptoms?

If you experience headaches, dizziness, nausea, or unusual fatigue, inform your guide immediately so appropriate action can be taken for your safety.

Q: Are your guides trained for high-altitude trekking?

Yes, our licensed guides are experienced in high-altitude trekking, first aid, altitude awareness, and emergency response procedures.

Q: Is emergency helicopter evacuation available?

Yes, emergency helicopter evacuation can be arranged when necessary, subject to weather conditions and travel insurance coverage.

Q: Is Wi-Fi available during the trek?

Wi-Fi is available in many lodges along the Everest trekking route, although service quality may vary depending on location and weather.

Q: Can I charge my electronic devices during the trek?

Most lodges provide charging facilities for phones, cameras, and other devices in every region in Everest Base Camp Trek.

Q: Will mobile networks work during the trek?

Mobile coverage is available in many parts of the Everest region through Nepal Telecom and Ncell, though signal strength may decrease at higher altitudes. Day at Lobuche and Gorakshep are networkless mostly.

Q: How much luggage can I bring on the Lukla flight?

Most domestic mountain flights allow approximately 10 kg of checked baggage and 5 kg of hand carry luggage per passenger.

If you want extra luggage, we can arrange that too. However, you are requested to make an early notice.

Q: Will a porter carry my luggage?

Yes, porters carry your main trekking bag, allowing you to walk comfortably with only a daypack containing essential items.

Q: What should I pack for the Everest Base Camp Luxury Tour?

You should pack warm clothing, trekking boots, a down jacket, waterproof layers, gloves, sunglasses, sunscreen, and personal medications. A detailed packing list will be provided after booking.

Q: Are ATMs available during the trek?

Limited ATM facilities are available in Namche Bazaar. We recommend carrying sufficient Nepalese currency before beginning the trek.

Q: Can solo travelers join this trek?

Yes, solo travelers are welcome and can join group departures or arrange a private Everest Base Camp Luxury Tour.
